Busting through Stacles

What are the obstacles you are facing, the ones that currently keep you from your calling to plant seeds of faith in your children?

1) PRAY

- I have too many kids for a good conversation
- I have too few kids for a good conversation
- My kids are too squirmy, they won't listen
- My kids are too little; they won't get it
- My kids are too big; it's too late
- My husband doesn't approve
- My husband doesn't help
- My kids are bored and distracted when we do anything God-related
- I feel like I'm lecturing my child when I talk about God
- I feel like I'm forcing my faith on my child instead of letting them develop their own relationship with God.
- My kids tune out when we talk about God

What does God say?

Ok friend, it's time to bring these obstacles to God. Why? Because we know that nothing is too hard for Him. (Jerermiah 32:27) We also know that He is the one who began this good work in you, and He has promised to see it to completion. (Philippians 1:6) He wants you to succeed!
